By completing the form, you will become a member of the Sawyers Mill Neighborhood Watch program which means you'll keep your "eyes and ears open" and if you see anything suspicious, you will report it to the Chesapeake Police Department. This program does not involve "patrolling" the neighborhood!

By becoming a member, you also have the option of participating in the following 3 programs:

Operation Identification Program

This simply involves engraving your household items with a number you create yourself and making an inventory of those engraved items. The list is private and need not be shared with anyone except the police in the event of a loss of property. The police department will provide the engraver.

Residence Security Survey Program

This is a program where you make an appointment with the police department and they will come to your home and provide you with recommendations on making your home more secure. The survey usually takes 20 minutes. If you are interested, please contact: Officer Diane Branch, at 382-6194 to make an appointment.

McGruff House Program

McGruff homes act as safe homes for children should the need arise while out in the neighborhood. All individuals, 18 and older, of these homes will need to submit to background checks performed by the police department.
